SCHOOL CYCLING CODE OF CONDUCT for bicycles and scooters

Cycling to school is healthy and is good for the environment. Our cycling code of conduct looks to promote the safety of cyclists, pedestrians and other road users.

I wish to cycle to school and I agree to:

Cycle along cycle routes or on the road if it is safe to do so.

Use safe crossing points and dismount my bicycle to cross the road.

Always wear a cycle helmet (when using a scooter, we highly recommended the wearing of a helmet as along with the big increase in the use scooters, there has been an increase in the number of scooter-related injuries).

Be polite and courteous to other road users, pedestrians and other members of the public.

Give clear signals to indicate that I wish to turn, change lane, etc.

Will not give people "rides" on my bicycle.

Use bicycle lights and wear high-visibility clothing, as appropriate.

Dismount my bicycle at the pedestrian entrance and walk with it to the cycle shed.

Not ride my bicycle on the school grounds.

Not allow anyone else to ride my bicycle.

Pupil: I agree to abide by the above code of conduct, and I understand that if I follow the rules, I will be allowed to cycle to school.
