Dear Parents and guardians,

Purpose of the visit	To enhance learning in Science, Art and English. The children will be taken on a tour around the gardens and learn about formal designs for stately homes and the work of Capability Brown. Children will also learn about the growth and care of animals in the farmyard. Follow up work will be completed after the trip.
Lunch	Packed lunch and drink required. (no chocolate, no fizzy drinks, sweets or yoghurt)
Clothes	School uniform with sensible walking shoes and coats for inclement weather.
Medication	Please ask the teacher for the form, which must be completed for all medicines taken on school visits, other than prescribed inhalers. This includes sickness tablets, where a single dose should be sent into school in a named envelope. All medication should be handed over by a parent to a member of school staff.
Pocket Money	None required.
Timing	Children need to be at school for 8.30. Will return by 4.15.
Insurance	Covered in payments.

I am sure you are all aware that school budgets are very tight and that it is necessary to ask for funding for extra-curricular visits. We do try to keep costs to a minimum and aim to provide real value for money. If insufficient contributions are received, the visit may have to be cancelled.

On this occasion we would ask for a contribution of £17.00 per child. Please speak to your child's class teacher as soon as possible if you have any difficulty with payment. If you intend to pay any amount before the Easter holidays, please do so in cash. Any payments after Easter may be made on-line using school money. If there are any queries please contact the school office. Any cheques should be made payable to Ravensdale Junior School.

A reduced payment (50%) of £8.50 is applicable for families who are currently eligible for the receipt of free school meals.
