Purpose of the visit	To enhance learning in Design Technology. Children will have the opportunity to learn about how pizzas are made and make their own pizza as part of our Food/D&T topic.
Lunch	We will return to school for lunch.
Clothes	School uniform with sensible walking shoes and coats for inclement weather.
Medication	Please ask the teacher for the form, which must be completed for all medicines taken on school visits, other than prescribed inhalers. This includes sickness tablets, where a single dose should be sent into school in a named envelope. <b>All medication should be handed over by a parent to a member of school staff.</b>
Pocket Money	None required.
Timing	Normal school times.
Insurance	Covered by school.

I am sure you are all aware that school budgets are very tight and that it is necessary to ask for funding for extra-curricular visits. We do try to keep costs to a minimum and aim to provide real value for money. If insufficient contributions are received, the visit may have to be cancelled.

On this occasion we would ask for a contribution of £2.50 per child. Please speak to your child's class teacher as soon as possible if you have any difficulty with payment.

Flamingos will be required to pay in cash before their trip in March.

Swans and Herons Cash payments only please, to be paid one week before their trip in May and June respectively.

A reduced payment (50%) of £1.25 is applicable for families who are currently eligible for the receipt of free school meals.
