**Visit to Toyota Manufacturing UK – Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

We are pleased to invite your child to an interactive workshop called 'Art of Manufacturing' which will be held at the Toyota Manufacturing UK vehicle production plant in Derby, on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July from 9.30am until 3pm (dependant on travel time).

The workshop is designed for school years 5 & 6 to promote STEM subjects and explores the exciting world of manufacturing through the use of a Lego production line, to build model cars. It will also give the children the opportunity to see, hear and use some of the tools that we make use of everyday when building cars. They will explore the world of Toyota in a safe and controlled environment.

Toyota has supported Young People education since 1992 and we are very excited to offer this programme and to engage with local primary children. The programme has been specifically designed to support the teaching and engagement of engineering and science subjects (STEM) within school.

As the first manufacturing plant for Toyota in Europe, car production began here in Derbyshire in 1992 and we employ over 3,000 members at our vehicle plant in Derbyshire and our Engine Plant in Deeside North Wales.
