Music in School


We are very keen that children have a good working knowledge of music by the time they leave us. For this reason, we have purchased a new scheme called Charanga. As well as being very engaging, it also teaches children how to read basic music using recorders or glockenspiels. We are using glockenspiels at the moment.

The Derby Music Partnership are working with Year 4, who are all learning to play the Ukulele. I sat in on part of a lesson last week and it looked great fun. We are just starting to offer guitar lessons in school and this is a great way to move on from the Ukulele.

There are various **peripatetic lessons** offered in school. All music lessons are subsidised by 50% if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding. The only requirement is that they practise and remember to bring their instrument every week. SEND bursaries are also available for Music Partnership teachers (Woodwind and violin) - see derbyshiremusichub.org.uk.

- **Woodwind** (flute, clarinet, saxophone) £10.50 for a 20-minute lesson and £15.50 for a 30-minute lesson with Miss Lord
- **Piano** £10 per 20 minutes with Ms Watkiss.
- **Violin** £5.00 for a 20min shared lesson , £7.00 for 15 min individual ,£10.00 for 20 min individual.
- **Rocksteady** (drums, keyboard, electric guitar, base guitar and singing) £37.29 per month
- **NEW! Guitar** (price will be available shortly)

Dinner Money Payments

Please remember that dinner money should be paid in advance. You wouldn't leave a restaurant and expect to be able to pay them later!! We run our own kitchen and have to pay for the food, wages, equipment etc.

From next week, any child who owes over £10 in dinner money will be given a simple sandwich and an apple for dinner. This is part of our policy. It may sound harsh, but parents can end up owing over £50 and when this applies to several parents, it starts to impact our budget significantly. £627 was overdue last week.

Thankfully it doesn't happen often, but we have pursued parents in the courts before now, even when the child has left the school, and have been successful. Parents have ended up having to pay far more than the initial debt.

Our school dinners are wonderful and great value. We are delighted that so many children enjoy them! Please try to remember to pay in advance, as this really helps the smooth running of our office.
